



## **Library K-8**

All students visit the school library weekly. They are permitted to check out two books at a time. If they are working on a class project, they may take out additional books. Students in grades K-4 have a regular weekly lesson that is appropriate to their grade level. They have the option of participating in reading incentive programs that are offered.

It is important that the students return books in a timely manner and respect the property of the school. If a student misplaces a book, the parent should write a note indicating the situation so that the student may continue to check out books while he/she is searching for the missing book. We want to teach the children responsibility, but we do not want to be punitive. It is very helpful if parents of primary students help them to remember their books on library day. If we cultivate good habits from the beginning, problems do not develop later.

The main purpose of the library program is to help the children develop a love of reading and become readers for life! In addition, we want to be sure they have the research skills necessary for academic success in the future.
