***PHYSICAL EDUCATION:**

STUDENTS ARE TO LEAVE A PAIR OF GYM SHOES IN SCHOOL AT ALL TIMES.

Those shoes will be worn for Phys. Ed. Shoes must have **UNMARKABLE SOLES.**

All students are to have a school bag

that is used everyday for transporting books back and forth to school.

No student is to have “White-Out” in school.

Workbooks and textbooks must be covered the first week of school

as directed by the teacher.

We ask that all supplies be available the first day of school

and refilled as needed throughout the year.

***** UNIFORM DRESS CODE FOR BOYS AND GIRLS (Grades 5-8) *****

BOYS:

<u>Trousers</u>	<u>Navy Blue</u> or <u>Black</u> dress pants.
<u>Shirts</u>	<u>White</u> or <u>Pastel Blue</u> dress shirt. (Shirts must be tucked in.)
<u>Ties</u>	Solid colors - <u>Navy Blue</u> , <u>Red</u> , or <u>Black</u> (NO ornamentation, neon, iridescence.)
<u>Socks</u>	<u>Navy Blue</u> , <u>White</u> , or <u>Black</u>

GIRLS:

<u>Uniform</u>	Skirt and white polo shirt - banded or straight bottom . Gr. 5 girls may still wear jumper with any white tailored blouse.
<u>Jewelry</u>	Small post earrings only - no hoops or dangling Other jewelry may be religious medals or small seasonal type pins. Only CLEAR NAIL POLISH is acceptable with nails properly maintained.
<u>Socks</u>	<u>Navy Blue</u> , <u>White</u> , or <u>Red</u> .

No Sport Socks (i.e., Tennis socks) - Above-the-Ankle socks ONLY

***SWEATERS**

- SOLID COLORS: Navy, White, Black, or Dark Red

NO ornamentation.

***SHORTS:**

Students may wear NAVY BLUE walking shorts with a regular uniform blouse or shirt
and school shoes during the times listed in the Handbook.

NO ARTIFICIAL HAIR COLORING IS ALLOWED ON GIRLS OR BOYS.
NO FAD HAIRSTYLES AND NO LONG SIDEBURNS ARE ALLOWED.
