

VIRTUS COMPLIANCY — IMPORTANT

The USCCB (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops) will be doing on-site audits at parishes in the Diocese of Cleveland. It is imperative that all who work with children - coaches, scout leaders and helpers, St. Mark Staff, catechists & teachers (PSR and DAY school), parent volunteers, etc. - are Virtus compliant. This means that one must be:

- Virtus trained (see below)
- **Current with reading on-line bulletins**
- Read and signed off on Policy for **Protecting Children**
- Read and signed off on **Standards of Conduct**
- Completed a **fingerprint check through OBCI & I**
- Filled out a **Volunteer Application**

All of the above-mentioned requirements are mandatory. (You can check your compliancy by going to “Virtus.org”, signing in, and clicking on the green ‘Training’ tab.) If you are not sure of your compliancy, call the Church Office (216-226-7577) and your compliancy will be verified. If one is not Virtus compliant, **YOU MAY NOT WORK WITH CHILDREN.**
