

Saint Mark Kindergarten-Grade 8 2026-2027 School Enrollment

Priority registration begins Sunday, January 18th for current St. Mark families with students in grades Preschool-8 for the 2026-2027 school year. Open registration begins Sunday, January 25th for families new to St. Mark.

KINDERGARTEN

Kindergarten students must be at least five years old on or before September 30, 2026.

TRANSFER STUDENT INFORMATION

Please note: St. Mark School does not accept transfer students for the eighth grade year except under circumstances deemed extraordinary by the administration. Acceptance decisions will be made upon interview, completion of admission forms, and payment of applicable registration and technology fees. Parish families have priority in cases where class space is limited.

Tuition Grades K-8: \$6,300

Registration Fee: \$200/child

Technology Fee: \$50/child

RE-ENROLLMENT DIRECTIONS FOR CURRENT ST. MARK FAMILIES:

- Check each child's name to re-enroll your student(s).
- Add any new students for the 2026-2027 school year. Please note, if you are enrolling a student for Preschool for the 2026-2027 school year, you must use the separate Preschool Registration link on the Admissions page of our school website.
- Tuition agreement is signed and the registration and technology fee payment method is chosen.

- Complete payment of registration and technology fees.
Fees are due at the time of registration.

ENROLLMENT DIRECTIONS FOR NEW PROSPECTIVE FAMILIES PRESCHOOL- GRADE 8:

- Add your new student(s).
- Add your address and family information and confirm. Please double check that all information is correct before you submit your registration.
- Tuition agreement is signed and the registration and technology fee payment method is chosen.
- Complete payment of registration and technology fees.
Fees are due at the time of registration.

New student registration must include the following:

- Completed school registration online using Digital Academy
- Copy of Child's birth certificate - uploaded to Digital Academy
- Certificate of Baptism (if applicable) - uploaded to Digital Academy
- **For Kindergarten students ONLY** - if your child did not attend St. Mark preschool provide a copy of their most recent preschool report card/ progress report - uploaded to Digital Academy
- Release of Records Form if transferring from another school
- Copy of custody/guardian papers (if applicable)

- Special Services Form
- Most recent report card and standardized test scores (transfer students grades 1-7)
- Admission interview with the Principal/Assistant Principal (transfer students grades 1-7)

You will receive a confirmation email once you have submitted your registration.

ALL FAMILIES REGISTERED FOR THE 2026-2027 SCHOOL YEAR

Cleveland Scholarship or EdChoice Expansion paperwork must be completed and submitted to the school office by March 1, 2025. **THIS IS NOT COMPLETED THROUGH DIGITAL ACADEMY.** The paperwork will be released by the Ohio Department of Education in early February.

PLEASE NOTE: Registration is NOT complete until all fees are paid in full, Cleveland Scholarship or EdChoice Expansion paperwork has been completed and all registration materials have been received.
